WORLD POLITICS: AMERICA AND THE WORLD: Speaker: Dr. Ralph Buultjens, at SHJC. For information, call 631-421-3224, ext. 14. Coordinated by Dr. Kay Sato, formerly of LIU, and Mr. Leonard Grubman. In the past century, America has faced three great international challenges (World Wars and the Cold War). With great efforts, it has survived successfully. Now, major developments are again shaking the existing political and economic power structure: the rise of China, Russian activism, Jihadist and other influences in the Middle East, Europe's decline, refugees, terrorism, etc. New factors (e.g., ultra-modern technologies, climate change) have become critical. Can American greatness be sustained? Is "America First" the answer? How does this country respond to changed world conditions? How do we relate to our traditional allies like Israel? Will this create new instruments of power, control and global influence? Who will be the winners and losers? What sort of world will emerge and what will be America's place in it? This program of lectures will discuss these and other critical issues in the context of current world affairs. **10:30 AM-Noon, OR, 1:00-2:30 PM. Total of 3 sessions: March 27, April 3, April 10. Fee: \$120.** The lecturer, DR. RALPH BUULTJENS, is an internationally recognized analyst of world politics and has served as senior professor at NYU and Cambridge University (UK); he is a frequent media commentator, author of ten books on world affairs, and has received several awards for teaching and scholarship. He is also a headline
